


## Update on blue heeler sisters Lucy and Bear

We weren't sure that Jake would ever be able to walk on his own when he arrived at the shelter in July with a severe back injury. Tests and an exam by Dr. Kendra were followed by meds to help relieve the pressure of his injured disks as his first steps to recovery. The meds were successful, but Jake needed more help to get those back legs working properly again. Because of a generous donation by supporter Dawn Rose for his care, we were able to look into the next step. Enter Cassie of Four Paws Rehabilitation Center. After a consult it was decided that the best course of action would be underwater treadmill therapy along with specific rehab exercises that we could do at the shelter and that could continue after adoption. Jake is thriving and walking so much better as we are in the middle of the 6 water therapy sessions. He has turned into a cooperative sweetheart, and his progress is very noticeable as he goes for his walks and completes his therapy exercises. Now to find this friendly guy a loving home. He so deserves it!

I may be a little more reserved than some of my fellow cats, but I also know how to have a good time and play with the best of them.




## STAN

I'm a pretty kitty who prefers all of the attention. I would love a home where I can be spoiled and snuggled all day long.




## GABBY


## ALFRED

Honey is a 5 year old Chesapeake that needs to find a new home - one that doesn't have cats or small dogs, but has humans that want to play with her and go for walks.




## JACK




## Janet the Foster Failure


